

Special Meeting, Council Hall,
November 26, 1934; 6:30 P. M.

A special meeting called by the president for the purpose of considering the purchase of a tract of land adjacent to Moss Spring was held on the above date.

Present: Councilmen, Walok, Gilland, Seibert, Hoachlander, Stever, Davison, and Friedly.

On motion of Dr. Gilland, seconded by Mr. Friedly, it was agreed to purchase from Mrs. Wm. R. Davison, for the sum of \$ 800.00, a piece of ground 40 x 60 feet surrounding Moss Spring with all rights to the water with the following provisions: That Mrs. Wm. R. Davison shall be relieved of any liability from lower riparian owners, and that if ever the

Borough shall decide to sell this piece of ground, that Mrs. Wm. R. Davison, or the then owner of the farm, shall have the first chance to purchase.

The vote on the above motion was as follows:-

For the motion: Walok, Gilland, Friedly, Seibert,
Against the motion: Stever, and Davison,
Not voting: Hoachlander.

On motion adjourned.
