

Special Meeting, Council Hall,
September 9, 1935, 8:30 P. M.

A special meeting, called by the President was held on the above date with the following present:-

President, Walck, and councilmen, Hoachlander, Stover, Gilland, Friedly and Davison.

President, Walck, appointed a committee composed of Messers Stover, Seibert and Gilland to call upon property owners along the proposed revised route of Route 11, and to attempt to secure rights of way 40 feet in width.

Meeting of Sep. 9, 1935 continued.

A Federal project for the laying or improving of sidewalks, in which the Federal government under WPA would furnish labor, provided the property owner would pay for materials was explained to Council. On motion Mr. Stover, seconded by Dr. Gilland, the treasurer was authorized to have printed and to receive applications and agreements for this work. Sep. 24th, 1935 was fixed as the last date upon which applications could be made.

The treasurer was also authorized to contact Mr. Hoke and Mr. Sharpe and ask them to try to have the contract with the P. R. R. for the track removal promptly ratified by the Public Service Commission.
