Congressional Redistricting Hearing: On October 13, I presented testimony at a public hearing before the Pa. House of Representatives Government Committee on Congressional Redistricting in which State Representative Paul Schemel is a member. I testified with my opinion that Franklin County should be kept whole in the 13th Congressional District. Also testifying was Mike Ross from the Franklin County Area Development Corporation and Sam Cressler, Supervisor, for Southampton Township in northern Franklin County.

Borough's Assn. Meeting: I represented Greencastle on October 19 at the Franklin / Cumberland County Boroughs' meeting in Shippensburg, hosted by Newburg Borough. Pa. State Assn. of Boroughs Deputy Director and Director of Education & Training Josh Ehrman was the guest speaker.
