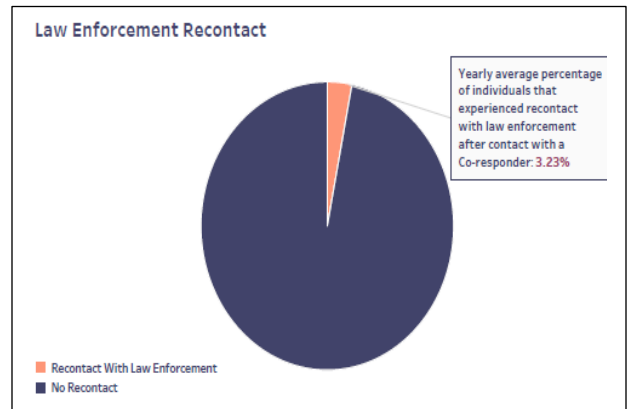
NOTEWORTHY ACTIVITIES:
