NOTEWORTHY ACTIVITIES:

At this time last year GPD had 2,928 calls for service compared to 3,356 this year, approximately a 15% increase.

It is with sadness that we have received a resignation of Off. Robert Petrunak (see attached). He has been with GPD for over 23 years as a full and part-time Officer. His absence will be a large void in our family.

We are currently exploring a DCED grant for the acquisition of Department needs. It is part of Federal funds recently released. It is not allowed for sworn staffing.

This past month Officers responded to a reported "Shots Fired" call on S Antrim Way. As a result of their response they took into custody an individual who fired multiple shots in several areas of town. They recovered a handgun from him in the course of the arrest.



An Officer on patrol located a distressed female running down a Borough street. Investigation found that she had been beaten and strangled in the course of a violent domestic. Ultimately the offender was located and arrested. We wish to thank the Franklin County Coroner's Office for their forensic assistance in the course of this investigation.

We wish to thank all who made the annual "Fish with a Cop" a successful event including the merchants and local businesses that supported it, the participating agencies and GPD's own Off. Jim Bradley. This program has been a huge success now

for 5 years after being initiated by Bradley. Kids of all backgrounds and Cops come together to relax, talk and fish, and all have a good time.
