Annual Bulk Drop Off for Borough Residents Scheduled for May 7 and 8 at Public Works Building

The Borough of Greencastle will conduct its annual bulk item drop-off on Friday, May 7 from 6:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Saturday, May 8, from 6:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at the Public Works Building, 40 Mifflin Lane. This program is provided to Borough residents only and identification will be required prior to disposal. Residents should be prepared to help with unloading their bulky waste and have a COVID-19 approved mask on at all times when outside their vehicles and in contact with Borough staff. If possible, residents are encouraged to plan ahead and coordinate large item loads with their neighbors or community.

New this year, tires will not be accepted for disposal and will be rejected. Electronics are also not acceptable for disposal.

Household Appliances: Microwaves, refrigerators, stoves, washers and dryers	Electronics: TVs, computers, monitors, keyboards, stereos, etc.

Air Conditioners	Yard Waste: Leaves, shrubs, tree clippings, etc.
Vehicle Batteries: Only 1 vehicle battery per license	Construction/Demolition Material: Lumber, drywall, sheeting, roofing materials, floor covering materials
Mattresses & Box Springs	Fencing/Wire/Cable
Lawn Equipment: Mowers, weed trimmers, etc.	Propane/Gas Bottles or Containers
Miscellaneous Bulk Items: Patio furniture, grills, swings, playsets, ladders, coolers, etc.	Concrete/Rocks/Bricks, Slabs
Scrap Metal	Batteries (other than one car battery per license)
