

**BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE  
(ORDINANCE NO. 2014-03)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE,  
FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA WITH RESPECT TO CHAPTER 190,  
VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,  
TO DECREASE EXISTING SPEED LIMITS OF  
30 AND 35 MILES PER HOUR TO 25 MILES PER HOUR ON  
SOUTH WASHINGTON STREET PURSUANT TO  
THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S  
SPEED LIMIT MODIFICATION STUDY AND SUBSEQUENT RECOMMENDATIONS.**

**IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle as follows:

SECTION I: Article II of Chapter 190 [Vehicles and Traffic] of the Code of the Borough of Greencastle, Section 190-9A [Speed limits established] is hereby amended as follows:

Street	Between	Modified Speed limit (mph)
South Washington Street	E. Baltimore Street and E. Leitersburg Street	25
South Washington Street	E. Leitersburg Street and Borough Limits	25

SECTION II: In all other respects, Chapter 190 [Vehicles and Traffic] of the Code of the Borough of Greencastle shall remain as previously enacted, ordained and amended.

SECTION III: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
