## **A. Community Development**

1. Authorize the drafting and advertising of an ordinance amending Chapter 205, Zoning, Section 56 "Definitions" and Section 27 "Sign Regulations" of the Borough of Greencastle Code to provide for electronic scoreboards at athletic venues, electronic message centers, information kiosks, and sandwich board signs and to amend in its entirety Section 27. (Advertising of said ordinance shall occur the week of March 17, 2014).

## **B. Personnel**

1. Adopt a Resolution approving tuition reimbursement for Police Officer Keith Russell subject to the criteria set forth in the current Borough of Greencastle Police Collective Bargaining Agreement of January 2012, Article XIII, with said tuition reimbursement fund specifically drawn from the Police Department Budget (01410). Furthermore, said approval/reimbursement shall remain in effect for those courses successfully completed prior to December 31, 2014, the expiration of the current Police Collective Bargaining Agreement. Thereafter, any and all coursework and associated reimbursement will be subject to any, and all, criteria agreed upon in future Collective Bargaining Agreement(s).

Authorize the drafting and advertising of an Ordinance amending the Code of the Borough of Greencastle, with respect to Chapter 190 "Vehicles and Traffic" to decrease existing speed limits of 30 and 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour on South Washington Street pursuant to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's Speed Limit Modification Study and subsequent recommendations.
