D. Public Safety

1. Adopt an Ordinance amending the Code of the Borough of Greencastle, with respect to Chapter 190 "Vehicles and Traffic" to decrease existing speed limits of 30 and 35 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour on South Washington Street pursuant to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's Speed Limit Modification Study and subsequent recommendations.
2. Consider rescinding Borough Council's February 3, 2014 action and approve a revised request from the Pub Run Executive Board of Directors (April 4, 2014) to close the streets outlined on said correspondence on April 19, 2014 from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. in order to conduct the Second Annual Flannery's Pub Run that benefits Greencastle Antrim and Tuscarora School Districts.

Furthermore, permit the closure of portions of Madison, Jefferson, North Washington, North Carlisle and Chambers Lane for the First "Morning Kid's Run" to take place from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. the same day (April 19, 2014).

Lastly, permit use of the Borough parking lot and vendor exhibits on North Washington Street (six spaces adjacent to John Allison House) from 7:30 a.m. through noon the same day (April 19, 2014).

(Note: If approved, these events shall be subject to the applicants providing valid Certificate of Liability Insurance Form(s) naming the Borough of Greencastle as an additional insured).
