Addendum #1 includes the following information:

- Answers and responses to bidder's RFI
- Updated prevailing wages that will replace the original (Appendix D) in the Bidding Documents (Contract No. 001-24)

Questions and Answers

1. Regarding the prevailing wage rates, the classification is listed as highway. There are highway and building rates in the bid documents, please confirm they are correct as highway and not building.
The corrected prevailing wages are included below and are to replace the original (Appendix D) in the Bidding Documents (Contract No. 001-24).
2. The specifications mention the successful bidder is responsible for all permits. Please clarify which contract will be responsible for permits and which permits will be necessary.
The Borough of Greencastle will be responsible for acquiring all proper permits.
3. Is there a specification for the brick that is to be used for repairing the brick wall?
On sheet S101, under "Structural Notes" under "Masonry" add the following note: "10.) Brick that is used to repair the existing brick wall shall be new brick and may be any solid, utility brick with a minimum 1000 psi compressive strength and installed with Type N mortar.
4. Please clarify which contract will be responsible for removal and reinstallation of the vinyl siding.
 - a. *For General Contractor: Include the removal and reinstallation of the vinyl siding as indicated in the documents in the scope of work.*
 - b. *For Trade Contractors bidding per the option in "Information and Instruction To Bidders", Item #38: The removal and reinstallation of the vinyl siding as indicated in the documents should be included in the scope of work of Contract #2 – Masonry Work.*
5. Please clarify which contract will be responsible for the weather barrier, through wall flashing and stainless steel drip edge.
 - a. *For General Contractors: Include the installation of weather barrier, thru wall flashing, and stainless steel drip edge as indicated in the documents in the scope of work.*
 - b. *For Trade Contractors bidding per the option in "Information and Instruction To Bidders", Item #38: The installation of weather barrier, thru wall flashing, and stainless steel drip edge as indicated in the documents should be included in the scope of work of Contract #2 – Masonry Work.*

6. When is the start date?
 - a. *The Borough would like for construction on this project to begin as soon as possible for the contractor(s) once the project has been formally awarded. Borough Council will review bids at their public meeting on October 7th with the project likely to be awarded at that meeting. Notice of Award and Notice to Proceed will follow pending satisfactory review of the contract documents by engineering and legal representatives.*

7. We were a bit confused on what the invitation meant by “option for three trade contracts each” and were just hoping to get a little more context on what that meant.
 - a. *As specified in the bid package, there are 3 different construction trades needed for this phase of the project. This phase is being bid by trade while including an overall total project cost bid option as well. Contractors are able to bid one, two, or all three of the trade scopes of work. Upon review of the bids received, the Borough reserves the right to award each trade separately to the lowest responsible individual contract bidders or the project collectively to the lowest responsible total project bidder.*

8. What point on the existing brick wall are we using to determine setting the gap between the brick wall and the new CMU wall? There is a stone at the bottom of the existing wall that sticks out quite a bit and we are trying to determine if we will need to figure time for cutting that back closer to where the brick faces are.
Align face of new CMU with face of new reinforced concrete ledge; refer to structural drawings for dimensions of concrete ledge. Air cavity dimension will vary across wall. Verify all dimensions and conditions in the field.
