

#### Training

On April 30th, Officer Morrow and I attended a seminar hosted by the Hagerstown Police Department in partnership with the Maryland Governor's Office for Crime Prevention. The seminar provided valuable insights into public safety and was a beneficial learning opportunity for enhancing our understanding of current issues and strategies in the field. GPD has initiated its annual firearms qualification training. Officers Morrow - Kamoie and I were invited by the Hagerstown Community College Police Department to participate in a session at the Hagerstown Police Department firearms range. Not only did we successfully complete the qualification process, but the day also included scenario-based training, which focused on dynamic movements and shooting techniques. The training covered essential drills, such as transitioning between lethal and less-lethal platforms, enhancing our officers' versatility and readiness.
