February Updates

Academy

According to Program Coordinator Joe Gray, the following was noted regarding Cadet Austin Pepple's performance at the Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP) Police Academy:

- Demonstrates consistent academic and physical improvement.
- Currently serving as Squad Leader, exhibiting initiative, accountability, and leadership among his peers.
- Ensures squad members are prepared daily and meet academy standards.
- Volunteers for additional assignments and responsibilities.
- No disciplinary or performance concerns reported.
- Overall performance remains exemplary.



Training

On February 9th through February 13th, I attended the FBI-LEEDA leadership training in Baltimore, Maryland. This course is part of a three-part leadership series designed for law enforcement supervisors, command staff, and executives. The training focused on leadership development, communication, decision-making, accountability, and organizational management. It also provided an opportunity to collaborate with other law enforcement professionals and discuss current challenges and best practices in policing.

On February 9th through February 11th, Officers Knopp and Creager attended a free training hosted by the Franklin County Public Safety Training Center. The training covered basic interview and interrogation techniques, along with legal considerations and practical application. The course provided additional training to support their investigative duties. On February 23rd through February 26th, 2026, Officer Morrow attended the Instructor Development certification training hosted by Indiana University of Pennsylvania. The course focused on instructional methods, lesson planning, and effective presentation skills for law enforcement instructors. This training is a requirement to be certified as an instructor through Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (MPOETC). The certification will allow Officer Morrow to instruct MPOETC-approved courses and assist with future departmental training.



Calls for Service and Notable Incidents

- Officer Morrow participated in a countywide traffic safety detail, which resulted in a DUI arrest.
- The department investigated an assault at Pizza Hut that resulted in serious bodily injury. Three (3) adults and one (1) juvenile were arrested.
- The department assisted with a multi-unit dwelling fire on S. Carlisle Street that involved one reported entrapment.

Technology and Case Support

- Department cameras were utilized to help resolve three (3) property damage incidents involving the U.S. Post Office mail drop-off box and two roadway signs that were struck by vehicles.

Special Operations and Interagency Support

- The department's drone was deployed four (4) times in support of various operations.

Ongoing Investigations

- The local DEA is now involved in the ongoing investigation of the recent robbery at Carl's Drug Store, reflecting an escalation in investigative resources and coordination. The investigation remains active, and we ask anyone with information to please come forward.
