## **Calls for Service and Notable Incidents**

Through the combined efforts of Officer Kamoie, Goodwill loss prevention, and Administrator Faight, with assistance from social media, a wallet lost by a young juvenile was recovered and returned. The wallet contained more than \$322 in allowance money.

New surveillance cameras have been installed and are now operational at the intersection of Walter Avenue and Route 11 and along East Baltimore Street.
