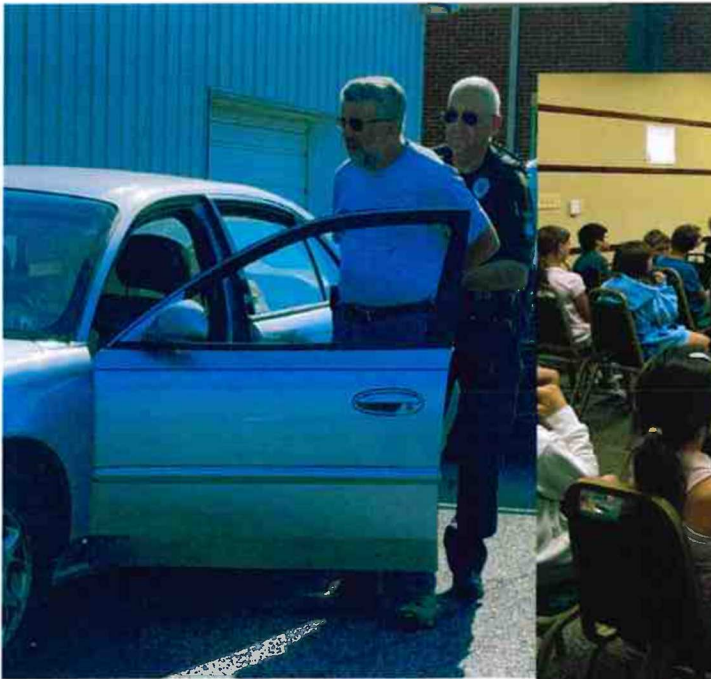

May Updates

Third-Grade Experience Day

During the month of May, Officers Creager and Knechtel, with assistance from Kevin Hunsberger, participated in the third-grade Experience Day at the District Judge's Office.

As part of the educational program, the officers helped present a mock criminal justice scenario for the students. The presentation included a traffic stop, an arrest, and a preliminary hearing involving a convicted felon in possession of a firearm. This event provided students with an opportunity to better understand the roles of law enforcement, the courts, and the judicial process in a hands-on and age-appropriate setting.



Jerome King Playground Restroom Vandalism

On May 16, 2026, three males vandalized the men's restroom at Jerome King Playground, including setting a fire inside the restroom. Fortunately, no damage was done.

Through the use of the Borough's surveillance cameras and social media, all three individuals were quickly identified. Officers are continuing to follow up on the incident as appropriate.

Nova Drive Standoff Incident

On the evening of May 28, 2026, officers responded to an incident on Nova Drive that began as a routine request for assistance after a male refused to help his wife out of bed.

The situation quickly escalated into an hours-long standoff involving an armed individual. Through the professionalism, coordination, and dedication of responding personnel, the incident was brought to a safe conclusion. The suspect was taken into custody without further injury.

This incident demonstrated the importance of effective communication, officer training, and coordinated response efforts during high-risk situations.

Washington Street and Baltimore Street Crosswalk Signals

Officers continued to monitor the new traffic pattern involving the crosswalk signals at the intersection of Washington Street and Baltimore Street.

This monitoring is ongoing to help ensure driver and pedestrian safety as motorists and pedestrians adjust to the updated traffic pattern.
