NOTEWORTHY ACTIVITIES:

Officers dealt with a female who showed up at GPD seeking help after reportedly freeing herself from a domestic incident where she was reportedly held at gunpoint. The incident happened at a location other than Greencastle.

There has been a spike in the number of accidents at the intersection of S. Antrim Way and Williamsport Pike. All are urged to use due caution in that area. We also remind everybody that intersection is part of the detour from the detour (I-81) during the upcoming Rt. 11 closure during the bridge replacement. You can potentially see an Interstate volume of traffic through that location. While we are not happy about that situation it was the decision of PA DOT to move forward as planned.

GPD was involved in an Animal Cruelty investigation which resulted in a number of charges being filed. We wish to thank the county Cruelty Investigator and Justice Rescue for their assistance. We also thank Chambersburg Police which received a "tip" about the situation on their tip line.
