

A state of emergency has been declared by Mayor Ben Thomas, Jr. and Council President Steve Miller for the Borough of Greencastle in coordination with a statewide emergency proclamation issued February 1 by Governor Tom Wolf.

The emergency declaration is in response to the noreaster that brought snow, sleet, ice and gusty winds to the area beginning January 31 and continues through February 2, 2021. Borough code enforcement regarding the removal of snow from sidewalks within 24 hours after a snow event ends will take effect Wednesday, February 3, once the emergency has been lifted.

Borough Public Works personnel continue to work toward keeping all roadways and streets open for travel as is their first priority.
