An adjourned session of the regular April 1st. meeting was held on the above date with the following present: *

Councilmen: Seibert, Stover, Friedley, Davison, and Gilland. President, L. R. Walck, presiding.

Antrim Township supervisors and Auditors were present, and were given statistive as to the average annual cost of maintaining our fire department, and the relative number of calls answered in town and country. Agreement as to an amount of contribution they might make was postponed until later.

On motion Mr. Stover, seconded by Mr. Davison, a resolution was passed authorizing the purchase of a tract of land by amicable agreement from Mrs. Frances Winger Davison. Said tract of land being adjacent to Moss Spring, and of the size and description as indicated by a draft made by County Surveyor John W. Atherton, March 30, 1935, and on file with the Borough Secretary. Text of resolution is recorded on Page No. 88 of the Borough Ordinance Book.

On motion of Mr. Stover, seconded by Mr. Gilland, a resolution was passed authorizing the purchase by amicable agreement of a tract of land from the L. H. Bitner Heirs. Said tract of land being adjacent to Moss Spring and of the size and description as given on a draft made by County Surveyor, John W. Atherton, dated Mar. 30, 1935, and on file with the Borough Secretary. Text of this resolution is recorded on pages 88 and 89 of the Borough Ordinance Book.

On motion of Mr. Stover, seconded by Dr. Seibert, the secretary was instructed to notify Mr. Hoke that the terms of the proposed agreement with the Penn'a. R. R. for removal of the track from Carlisle Street was agreeable except that Council desired that the track be removed to a point approximately 225 feet farther north from the point specified, to the switch leading to the Omwake Bros. Elevator. Agreement and blue-print to be returned with the request that the above change be made.

On motion, Thursday, April 25th. was designated "clean-up day."

A draft to the amount of \$ 1448.00 was authorized to be paid the Citizens National Bank for bonds and coupons redeemed.
