

Special Meeting, July 2, 1935

A special meeting, called by the President was held on the above date with the following present:-

President, L. R. Walck, Councilmen, Stover, Gilland, Seibert, Davison, and Friedley.

On motion, Mr. Davison, seconded by Dr. Gilland, the motion passed at the July 1st, meeting, authorizing purchase by the Burgess of a car for the police department valued at less than \$ 600.00 was rescinded.

On motion, Mr. Davison, seconded Dr. Gilland, the following motion was passed:- "That the Burgess be authorized to purchase a car for the police department for an amount not exceeding \$ 500.00

Messers Hoachlander and Stover were appointed a committee to confer with Mr. Hoke concerning a reduction in his bill for \$ 250.00 rendered for service in the G. M. Johnson suit, and to pay the same provided satisfactory concessions are made.

On motion, Council agreed to order electric light Company to install light at School House as requested by the School board, provided the siad board would pass a resolution and transmitt the same in writing to the Town Council agreeing to pay all costs of installation and operation.
