Regular Meeting, Council Hall,  
December 2, 1935, 7:00 P. M.

The regular December meeting of Council was held on the above date with the following present:-

Burgess Shinham, President L. R. Walck, and Councilmen, Gilland, Seibert, Davison, Friedly, Stover, & Hoachlander.

Minutes of the last regular meeting were read and adopted without correction.

Treasurer, Chas. W. Bert, Jr. reported as follows:-

Balance in Boro Account, - - - - -	\$	1765.04
Balance in Bond Account, - - - - -	\$	3537.88

Police Chief, Ambrose, reported 12 arrests during November and fines collected amounting to \$ 91.00

The secretary reported receipts for the Boro Account totaling \$ 383.31; and for the Bond account the amount of \$ 443.11

On motion, the above three reports were approved and adopted.

Bills totaling \$ 1225.08 were presented and on motion, drafts were ordered. (Full list of bills in ledger.)

Water Manager Bert reported the electric pump at Moss Spring in operation for 39 days, with a cost for this period of \$ 251.70

On motion Dr. Seibert, seconded by Mr. Stover, the old gasoline engine formerly used at Moss Spring was ordered sold to Philip Shank at the price of \$ 15.00

Water Manager Bert, reported a refund of \$ 5.15 made to L. A. B. Fleming for water rents. A meter having been installed.

On motion Dr. Seibert, seconded by Mr. Stover, Mr. Hoachlander and Mr. Bert were authorized to purchase all necessary supplies and materials for the Franklin Street project. Purchases to be made to the best advantage of the town.


On motion Mr. Stover, seconded by Dr. Seibert, that roofing for Moss Spring be purchased from the lowest bidder.

On motion Mr. Stover, seconded by Dr. Seibert, that the road roller be repaired at the estimated cost of about \$ 30.00.

On motion Mr. Stover, seconded by Mr. Friedley, that a culvert be constructed on Rupley Avenue in the rear of the school-house.

On motion Mr. Davison, seconded by Dr. Seibert, that the Pub. Property committee be authorized to purchase a concrete mixer from the First National Bank for the sum of \$125.00; also the steam roller, provided the same will pass inspection.
