



## ORDINANCE NO. 2021-01

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, NAMING UNNAMED BOROUGH-OWNED ALLEYWAYS POSITIONED WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE

**WHEREAS**, there are numerous unnamed public alleys that connect various intersections throughout the Borough of Greencastle and are owned and maintained by the Borough of Greencastle.

**WHEREAS**, Borough Council deems the naming of the unnamed Borough alley that connect numerous intersections within the Borough of Greencastle to be in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the Borough's citizens.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1: The Borough-owned alleys that connect the intersections described below shall be named as follows:

Section 2: Signs having the name of each alley shall be erected by the Borough in such locations as the Borough deems necessary to allow for the appropriate identification of the alley by citizens, pedestrians, and vehicular traffic.

Section 3: Repealer. All provisions of previous ordinances of the Borough of Greencastle, or parts thereof, which are contrary or inconsistent to this Ordinance, are expressly repealed.

Section 4: Savings Clause. In all other respects, the Borough of Greencastle shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.


Section 5: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the law.
